



Students for Senegal Annual Report

For the year: 01/01/2016 - 12/31/16



Our Mission is to expand educational opportunities in Senegal by constructing learning centers, empowering women and girls and promoting cultural exchange.

This year, we have accomplished the following:

- Completed fundraising for phase I of the Lambaye Learning Center
- Contracted with Senegalese architecture firm DMT Architecture and Engineering firm New Bat and Co to finalized designers for the LLC and begin the construction process
- Sponsored a service learning trip to Senegal with 25 MHS students
- Funded tuitions of more than 50 preschool children in Lambaye, Senegal
- Raised over \$8,000 from Senegalese donors including the town of Lambaye
- Collected and shipped computers, tablets, science equipment soccer equipments, medical supplies and school supplies to Lambaye
- Raised money through bake sales, a Soccer for Senegal tournament and merchandise sales
- Raised over \$50,000 from our Gala in June 2016
- Established the Baobab Tree of Giving which has raised over \$20,000 to support the LLC Construction
- Expanded our board to include two new advisory members Scot Mackie and Scott Miller



Plans for the future

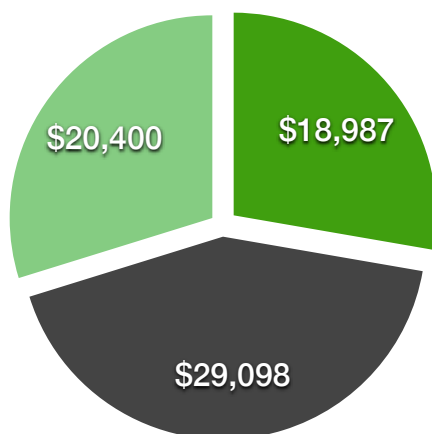
This year the focus will be on facilitating and overseeing the construction of the Lambaye Learning Center Phase I. Phase I will include a library reading room, computer lab, multipurpose space, out door stage and theater, exterior property walls, offices and bathrooms. We have also secured a trained librarian to act as the LLC director and be intimately involved in the planning and construction efforts. DMT Architecture will be overseeing the project for us and New Bat and Co is supply engineering diagrams and will complete all engineering work. Bidding for builders will begin in January 2017. BSKS will remain the chief architects of the project and will communicate with contractors in Senegal and oversee all efforts.

We also plan to continue with our pre school scholarships and sending school supplies, sneakers and dental supplies to Lambaye. Additionally we plan to start a new initiative aimed at rewarding Lambaye's highest performing students, particularly females, with stipends as they go on to high school. Fundraising will also continue for phase II of the LLC and we will seek to obtain Photovoltaic cells for the LLC and furniture, books and computers.
